The organisers of any Leeds' inter school competitions may submit a claim along with any corresponding receipts to the LSSA; the claim will be considered at a LSSA meeting. LSSA meetings are open meetings and colleagues are welcome to attend, please contact c.pyatt@priesthorpe.org to be included on the LSSA distribution list.

Claims can be submitted for the following:

- Venue hire
- Expenses for officials
- Medal / trophy purchase.
- Venue hire.

Examples of previous claims for funding are:

- School Sports associations such as Leeds Schools Football and Athletics.
- Local Sports Associations such as Morley School Sports Association.
- Individual schools or colleagues from schools who organise sporting events i.e St Bart's Cup for primary school girls
- School Sports Partnerships.

This whole city approach enables a system to operate which supports colleagues who take on the responsibility for organising events, festivals and competitions for school children in Leeds.

Data Collection Tool

Completing the Data Collection Tool will support 5 schools in highlighting improvements to Ofsted with what you offer to pupils in Physical Activity, PE and Sport through the use of the PE and Sport Premium funding. Completing the survey will also assist in collating data for other awards such as the School Games Mark.

On completion of the data collection, the tool produces, for each school, an impact report which can be published on the school website.

The Tool also has other useful features such as a pupil survey.

The access code for the Data Collection Tool will be sent to schools directly from Dan Wilson at West Yorkshire Sport.

Skills2Achieve Lite

Skills2Achieve is a planning and assessment tool for physical education that tracks the progress of the whole child through a multi-ability approach to learning. It supports improving the health and wellbeing of pupils, helps to drive achievement and impacts whole school improvement.

Schools will receive the link to access the Skills2Achieve Lite resource directly from the YST.

Primary Leadership Resource - Active Schools Mini Leaders Award.

This is leadership programme that will develop leadership skills in children and a workforce to support all your PE and Sporting activities; a great method of increasing physical activity levels across your whole school.

This is a FREE resource designed specifically for Active Schools that includes teacher's notes, lesson plans, student handbook and certificate. This course can be delivered in one hour sessions over six weeks.

Outcomes:

- Develop leadership skills and confidence in children.
- Engage your least active children through leadership roles.
- Develop a School Games Workforce - officials, coaches and a School Sport Organising Crew.
- Develop an energetic team to support with PE lessons, playground activity, organisation of equipment, team managers, sports days and inter school sport.
