The 2016 - 2017 Sport Premium funding for our school was received in two separate payments. The first payment was £3837 and the second payment was £5163

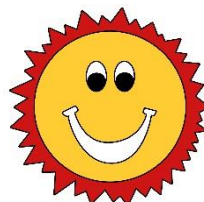
The total amount = £9000.00

The school received the **GOLD** School Games mark in June 2016

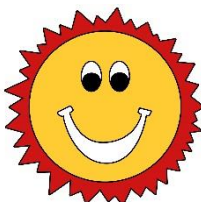

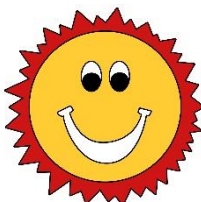

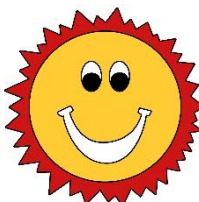
